Dear friends,

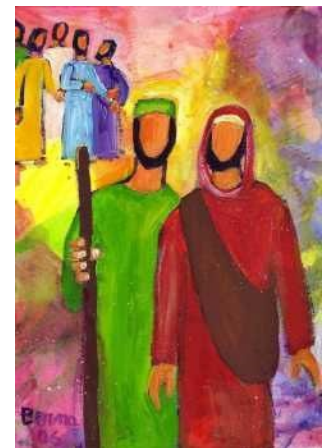
One of Pope Francis' biggest hits was a document called "The Joy of the Gospel". In short, it says that if our faith doesn't appear to be attractive in the way in which we live our lives, then faith won't be seen to be attractive to anyone else. Pope Francis was talking about living the simple joy of faith amid the ordinary things of life. At one point he says, some Christians look as though they have just come back from a funeral, and that for some, their whole lives are like Lent without Easter. At the basis of what Pope Francis is saying is something very simple: We tend to think of missionaries as people who travel off to missionary lands, but he says, we are all missionaries here, in this place. We are called to be missionary disciples. Pope Francis isn't saying anything particularly new; he is simply reminding us of what Jesus has called us to do.

Pope Francis talks about the need to build-up evangelising communities. Catholics sometimes shudder when they hear the word "evangelisation". We can think of those who go around knocking on doors or standing on street corners or of those people who want to know whether you have accepted Jesus as your personal Lord and Saviour. However, the word evangelisation comes from the word for "Gospel" which simply means "Good News". Jesus sent his disciples out to be people of Good News. Every Christian community is called to be a community of Good News.

Evangelisation at its most basic is simply living the Gospel – living in the way that Jesus calls us to, as an attractive, inviting and perhaps even curious, every day witness to faith.

We need communities that are willing "to go" beyond themselves and attempt to engage and accompany people amid the realities of their lives. In the words of Pope Francis, "We need a Church capable of walking at people's side, of doing more than simply listening to them; a Church which accompanies them on their journey; a Church able to help them make sense of their struggles and doubts and questions; a Church which realizes that the reasons why people leave also contain reasons why they can eventually return."

We might think that we have not much to offer. But according to today's gospel, that is exactly how Jesus sends us out – with nothing expect our faith.
