The year of celebration for the 150th anniversary of the Cathedral continues to unfold. One the eve of the Feast of Sts. Peter and Paul, we will be acknowledging the Sacrament of Holy Orders which have been celebrated in the Cathedral since its opening in 1874. Archbishop Mark Coleridge will preside at the 10am on Wednesday, 28th June and you are invited to be part of this celebration and gather in thanksgiving for the service and ministry of the many ordained ministers who have the served the local church of Brisbane generously and faithfully across 150 years.

Fr Martin Mulhall was the first priest ordained in the new St Stephen's Cathedral in 1877. This was the fourth ordination in Brisbane, with the previous three all being ordained in, what is now, St. Stephen's Chapel.

Bishop Robert Dunne, the second bishop of Brisbane was the first episcopal consecration in St. Stephen's in 1882. Therefore, there is a long history of the Sacrament of Holy Orders being part of the history of this Cathedral. During the course of the next 12 months or so, we will have celebrations for marriages, sacraments of Initiation, memorial for the faithful departed and other events to commemorate the liturgical life of the Cathedral.
