Dear friends,

After Lent, Easter and various feast, we are back in green today. We can think of Ordinary Time as being "ordinary". In reality, we spend most of our lives being "ordinary". There's an ad on TV at the moment which advertises some brand of prepared food and asks why we say that we are "doing nothing special" when we are sharing time with the people we most care about or spending time together at home.

The same could be asked of our attitude to "ordinary time". We can think of it as simply routine time, as if we are marking time and counting down to the next big event. Ordinary time is not the time in-between the major seasons; it is the longest season of the church's year. Ordinary time is where life happens and that is something to be intentional about and to celebrate. There is nothing ordinary about it.

There is a reason why the colour of ordinary time is green because green is the colour of growth and change. Like the plants and trees, most growth happens slowly and gradually, and often enough, we barely notice because we are caught-up in the hurry of things. So ordinarieness is not something to be dismissed, or even missed for that matter; it is a gift and if we take hold of the gift, we can appreciate the value of time and small joys of life's rhythms.

Each day is an opportunity for growth, even if just a little. We will either grow or diminish one way or another but the promise of Ordinary Time is that each day holds the potential gift of a small sprig of new life offered among the

mundane, the challenges, the failures, the successes, the sorrows and blessings of each simple, ordinary moment. *Fr Anthony*


