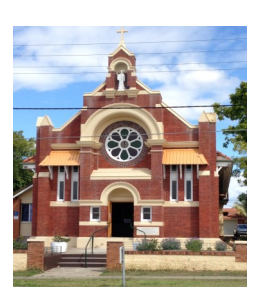

VINNIES IN OUR PARISH Firstly, a warm thank you to the parishioners and friends of parishioners who have offered various items of clothing and household goods for distribution through the Vinnies, including our local parish conference. Parishioners can be assured these items donated will be put to good use and are always valued by the recipients. We received a substantial donation of bed linen which has been packaged and ready to pass on to people who request this form of help. A large supply of furniture items that are no longer required has been received from Churchie in East Brisbane.

Our members continue to make visits twice a week to various households within our local area. We are averaging around 10 -12 visits weekly providing food parcels, clothing vouchers, and access to furniture and financial support in some instances. We have welcomed 2 new members in recent months.

We wish to take this opportunity to advise parishioners we will be conducting our annual cash collection for our **winter appeal after masses on the weekend of July 22,23**. This is the only occasion during the year where we seek the support of the parish in terms of actual donations of cash. We are always reminded of the scripture reading of the widow's mite where Jesus describes the simple offering of two small copper coins to the temple treasury is a wonderful gift because it represents a greater proportion of her wealth than larger gifts. We will be able to provide formal receipts for people who request a receipt in response to their donation.
