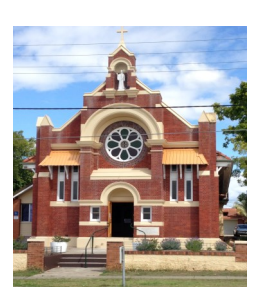

Safeguarding Sunday

The Catholic Church in Australia will also mark Safeguarding Sunday this weekend - 10 September.

This day seeks to acknowledge the immense damage caused by the abuse, exploitation and neglect of children and vulnerable adults within Catholic contexts. It commits to safeguarding practices and protocols that create and maintain safe environments. It also invites people to pray for those harmed by abuse directly and indirectly.

The Australian Catholic Bishop's Conference has prepared a series of resources with a theme "Safe and
